Brief Descriptions of Volunteer Options

Carnival: Evening activity in the Fall. Full Carnival feel with lots of booths with great fun for the entire family

Field Day: End of the school year fun for all kids! Lots volunteers needed to help with individual activities during morning and afternoon sessions

Run for the Arts: Volunteers help organize Run for the Arts and encourage student participation. Proceeds from this event funds school-wide performances, workshops and residencies by local artists and musicians

Spirit Week: At the end of the year, one day per month (5 days total). Communicate with community about theme of days and get the Maple Bars on PJ Day

Book Baggers: Celebrating over 30 years! Overnight activity at Maplewood (they stay in the gym) for grades 3, 4 & 5. Need lots of volunteers to organize activity booths for kids and to chaperone

Clothing Center: Volunteers report to the Portland PTA Clothing Center on one of Maplewood's assigned mornings to help distribute used clothing to area students

Walk/Bike Month & Day: A free competition between students of all ages to walk, bike, scoot, or skate to school.

Book Harvest: Gently used and new books donated to the Children's Book Bank by PTA to donate to children without access to books in their homes

Drop Off Traffic Helper: Direct traffic flow safely through the drop off lane. Help kids stay safe in walking area near fence

Lunch Room Volunteer: Supervise children (grades K/1 & 2/3) during lunch

Playground Volunteer: Supervise children during lunch recess once after receiving training on guidelines **Maplewood Foundation:** Parent-lead, non-profit fundraising group that fundraises to support staff at Maplewood

Hospitality: Help with weekly parent coffee, meals with teachers & events that bring the community inside our building. Coordinating donations of food by parents and run Teacher Appreciation week (all via email)

Reading Friends: Work one on one with a student helping in reading; typically once or twice a week for 30 minutes. Requires a weekly commitment and is invaluable to teachers and students

Garden Committee: Help maintain & improve natural spaces around Maplewood

Chess Club: Organize students and parents into meeting once per month (or more if desired) after school to learn and play chess

Lego Robotics: After school club with good guide information and material available (commitment similar to coaching a sports team)

Hearing/Vision Screening: Assist with student vision & hearing screenings. One day commitment

TAG: Organize Maplewood kids and parents who are TAG identified

Green Team: Help maintain and improve environmental practices at Maplewood (classroom composting, recycling, etc)

Wellness: To work with Maplewood kids to encourage health and wellness

eScrip: Organize eScrip program by encouraging participation and maintaining Maplewood account

Yearbook: Work with yearbook company to organize sales and distribution of Maplewood yearbook (All year commitment)

MW Photographer: Work with Yearbook to take candid photos of Maplewood kids at various school sponsored activities

Box Tops: Encourage participation and collect box tops & labels for education in school hallway donation sites

Scholastic Book Fair: Work simple cashier duties in shifts of hours. Event runs for one week

Spirit Wear: Help in design and sale of Maplewood gear

Native Plant Sale: Garden committee hosts annual sale of native plants

Read Aloud-a-thon: About a 2 hour commitment the day of event verifying pledges and gathering forms

Hanging Baskets: Once per year sale of hanging baskets (spring)

School Pictures: Help with classes coming into have school pictures taken.

Reader Board: Weekly commitment to update outside reader board. THIS IS A MUCH-NEEDED JOB

Website: Help manage and keep PTA website up-to-date and working efficiently

Bulletin Board: Maintain bulletin board in hallway of main building
